Number of Cases Requested from Supreme

The Connecticut State Council will purchase a total of 360 coats equaling 30 cases. We ask that Supreme match this order and provide an additional 30 cases. This will allow 20 cases or 240 coats to be distributed at each of our three distribution locations for 720 coats.

Funding

Coats will be purchased by the Connecticut State Council with funding support from our local councils, who have been fundraising and promoting these distributions throughout the state.

Area Demographics

- New Haven – The poverty rate is 25.6%. One out of every 3.9 residents lives under the poverty line
- Hartford – The poverty rate is 30.5%. Hartford has the highest poverty rate in Connecticut
- Bridgeport – Over 36.5% of children under six live in poverty, and 30.6% of children ages 6 to 11 live in poverty

The state deputy or another member of the state office will offer an opening prayer, followed by a short speech by our guest speaker. The event will conclude with a closing prayer by the State Chaplain or Bishop if he can attend.
