

***Into the Breach: The Dignity of Work* FAQs**

1) What is the *Into the Breach: The Dignity of Work* video series?

Into the Breach: The Dignity of Work is the latest entry in the Knights of Columbus *Into the Breach* video series. This dynamic new series explores the Catholic vision of man's mission in the world, focused on the role of work. The five episode series follows the Knights of Columbus' highly successful *Into the Breach* and *Into the Breach: The Mission of the Family* video series, which have been viewed over 3 million times.

2) What does each episode consist of?

Each episode focuses on a different aspect of the experience of human work and features expert interviews with well-known Catholic commentators, as well as the powerful personal story of a Catholic man who has lived the theme of the episode in his own life. Each episode runs approximately 12 minutes.

3) What is *Into the Breach: The Dignity of Work* about?

Much of our modern culture is beset with confusion and contradictions concerning the meaning and purpose of human work. *Into the Breach: The Dignity of Work* examines the nature of work and its role in a man's life and his sanctification, as well as its role in ordering creation.

4) What is the goal of *Into the Breach: The Dignity of Work*?

The goal of *Into the Breach: The Dignity of Work* is to help Catholic men understand the Catholic vision of human work and aid men in embracing and living this vision so they can integrate meaningful and fulfilling work into their lives.

5) What are the names of the five *Into the Breach: The Dignity of Work* episodes?

The five episodes are titled:

- God's Mission for Man
- Work and Holiness
- Work Life and Family Life
- Work and the World
- Putting Work in Its Place

Through *Into the Breach: The Dignity of Work* men are invited to reflect on the truth about the meaning of human work and how to live that truth in their own experience of work. The series can be used by individuals or in group settings – particular *Cor*. To facilitate small group discussion, the series has a companion study guide. This study guide can also be used for individual reflection on the series.
