What is Habitat for Humanity?

Habitat for Humanity is a nonprofit, Christian organization founded in 1976. Habitat partners with people in your community, and all over the world, to help build or improve a places for those in need to call home. Habitat homeowners help build their own houses alongside volunteers and pay an affordable mortgage.

Mission

Housing insecurity touches nearly half of adults at some point in their lives. 1 in 8 people worldwide live in urban slums. A lack of clean water and sanitation claim the lives of nearly 2 million young children a year. The numbers continue to grow and the slum challenge remains a critical factor for the persistence of poverty in the world.

Impact

Habitat for Humanity is responsible for providing quality shelter for more than 13 million people in more than 100 countries. The homes provide stability, safety and security for families and children.
